Faculty of Humanities has the following equipment and facilities:

1. Computer center: This center is available to BA, MA, and PhD students and could be used for graduate courses as well.
2. Language laboratory: It has 48 single cabins equipped with audio and video systems and is currently used for audio-visual courses of the English and Arabic departments.

3. Physical education laboratory: This highly equipped laboratory is used in the fields of exercise physiology and motor behavior sciences.
4. Danesh Hall: This two-story hall equipped with highly advanced audio, visual, and lighting systems is used for various purposes including conferences and student events.
5. Study hall: This hall provides students with a comfortable atmosphere for reading and research purposes.
6. Study hall for professors and PhD students: This hall has sufficient space and includes various reference materials and academic journals.
7. Meeting hall: This hall is used for various purposes including meetings of the educational council of the faculty as well as professor recruitment and viva sessions.
8. Audio-visual room: This room which is equipped with a video projector is used for viva as well as PhD interview sessions. In addition, 14 out of 10 classes on the ground floor and all 10 classes on the first floor are equipped with video projector.
